Scope for guideline update (starting 2025)

Abortion care: anti-D prophylaxis

NICE is updating its guideline on Abortion care NG140.

1 Who the guideline update covers

The current guideline covers women, trans men and non-binary people with female reproductive organs of any age (including people under 18) who request an abortion. The groups covered by the guideline will remain unchanged.

Equality considerations

<u>The original equality impact assessment for the guideline</u> lists equality issues identified and how they have been addressed and explains why any populations were excluded from the scope.

There are no new equality considerations specific to this update.

2 Activities, services or aspects of care covered by the guideline update

We will look at the evidence and key external guidance and consider making new recommendations or updating existing recommendations on:

 Anti-D prophylaxis in women, trans men and non-binary people with female reproductive organs having medical or surgical abortions (recommendations 1.3.1 to 1.3.4).

For all other areas of the guideline:

- There will be no evidence review.
- We will retain the existing recommendations but we may revise them to ensure consistency.

3 Draft review questions

We have identified the following draft review question:

For an unsensitized Rh-negative individual seeking abortion at <12 weeks gestation, is no administration of anti-D a safe and effective alternative to routine anti-D administration?

Note that guideline recommendations for medicines will normally fall within licensed indications; exceptionally, and only if clearly supported by evidence, use outside a licensed indication may be recommended. The guideline will assume that prescribers will use a medicine's summary of product characteristics to inform decisions made with individual patients.

We will take economic aspects into account when making recommendations.
