 - Qs 3.1 What is the most effective treatment for early rectal cancer?
- **Qs 3.4** What is the most effective preoperative radiotherapy or chemo radiotherapy regimen for rectal cancer?
- **Qs 3.5** Which patients having neoadjuvant chemotherapy or chemoradiotherapy for rectal cancer do not need surgery?
