1. Welcome and objectives for the meeting

The Chair welcomed the committee members to the second meeting for the colorectal cancer (CRC) guideline update.

The Chair informed the Committee that apologies had been received as noted above.

The Chair outlined the objectives of the meeting, which included:

- Review 1.1 and recommendations drafting by the committee;
- Developing 4 protocols for review questions 3.6, 4.3, 5.2 and 5.3;

The minutes of the first colorectal cancer guideline committee meeting were confirmed with the committee.

The Chair led round the table introductions for the group. A new committee member joined the group (CD).

The Chair confirmed that, for the purpose of managing conflicts of interest, the matter under discussion was colorectal cancer.

2. NICE Public Involvement

The Chair introduced EW who presented to the committee about patient and carer involvement in guideline development.

3. Develop protocols for review question 3.6. What is the optimal surgical technique for rectal cancer after preoperative radiotherapy and chemotherapy?

The Chair introduced MK (NGA Systematic Reviewer) who presented the protocol for review question 3.6 and finalised it with the committee.

4. Develop protocol for review question 5.2. What is the optimal management of low anterior resection syndrome?

The Chair introduced AT (NGA Systematic Reviewer) who presented the protocol for review question 5.2 and finalised it with the committee.

5. Develop protocol for review question 5.3. What are the information needs of people prior, during and after treatment for colorectal cancer?

The Chair introduced AT (NGA Systematic Reviewer) who presented the protocol for review question 5.3 and finalised it with the committee.

6. GRADE presentation

The Chair introduced NB (NGA Senior Systematic Reviewer) who presented to the Committee how the GRADE process takes place and its role in guideline development. NB then took questions from the group.

7. Review 1.1 How effective is aspirin in the prevention of colorectal cancer in adults with clinical or genetic evidence of Lynch syndrome (hereditary nonpolyposis colorectal cancer)?

The Chair introduced MK (NGA Systematic Reviewer) who led the committee through review 1.1, drafted recommendations with the committee and took questions from the committee.

8. Develop protocols for review questions 4.3.

The Chair introduced AT (NGA Systematic Reviewer) who presented the protocol for review question 4.3 and finalised it with the committee.

A decision was made with the committee to not cover the latter part of the review question 4.3.d as shown below:

Qs 4.3 (split into 4 different questions for protocol development purpose):

- a. What is the optimal combination and sequence of local and systemic treatments in patients presenting with oligometastatic colorectal cancer in the lung?
- b. What is the optimal combination and sequence of local, loco-regional and systemic treatments in patients presenting with oligometastatic colorectal cancer in the liver?
- c. What is the optimal combination and sequence of local and systemic treatments in patients presenting with isolated metastatic colorectal cancer in the peritoneum?
- d. What is the optimal combination and sequence of local and systemic treatments in patients presenting with oligometastatic colorectal cancer in the lymph nodes? (question will not be covered in the guideline).

9. Any other business

No other business was discussed.
