Appendix A: Antiplatelet therapy

Acute coronary syndromes search strategy- antiplatelets

This literature search strategy was used for the following reviews;

- Which antiplatelet is most clinically and cost effective for managing unstable angina or NSTEMI or for managing STEMI in adults?

The literature searches for this review are detailed below and complied with the methodology outlined in Developing NICE guidelines: the manual 2014, updated 2018.{NICE2014}

A.1 Clinical search literature search strategy

Searches were constructed using a PICO framework where population (P) terms were combined with Intervention (I) and in some cases Comparison (C) terms. Outcomes (O) are rarely used in search strategies for interventions as these concepts may not be well described in title, abstract or indexes and therefore difficult to retrieve. Search filters were applied to the search where appropriate.

A.2 Health Economics literature search strategy

Health economic evidence was identified by conducting a search relating to acute coronary syndromes population combined with terms for interventions in NHS Economic Evaluation Database (NHS EED – this ceased to be updated after March 2015) and the Health Technology Assessment database (HTA) with no date restrictions. NHS EED and HTA databases are hosted by the Centre for Research and Dissemination (CRD). Additional searches were run on Medline and Embase using a filter for health economics studies.

F.2 Health Economics literature search strategy
