1. Welcome and objectives for the meeting

The Chair introduced Eva Gonzalez, Systematic Reviewer, who presented the evidence review for IoLQ4: How should labour be induced in women with IUFD who have had a previous caesarean birth?

The Chair introduced Louise Geneen, Systematic Reviewer, who presented the evidence review for IoLQ3: At what gestational age should induction of labour be offered if spontaneous labour does not ensue?

The Chair introduced Paul Jacklin, Senior Health Economist who presented a health economic review on IoLQ3: At what gestational age should induction of labour be offered if spontaneous labour does not ensue?

5. Afternoon presentations

The Chair introduced Hilary Eadon, Guideline Lead, who led the committee through a

review of previously drafted recommendations for the caesarean birth guideline.

The Chair introduced James Gilbert, Senior Systematic Reviewer, who presented a protocol on EPMQ1: What is the clinical and cost effectiveness of progesterone in improving outcomes in women with threatened miscarriage?

6. Questions and discussions

The committee discussed the evidence for IoLQ3 and IoLQ4, and drafted recommendations. The committee also discussed the protocol for EPMQ1, made contributions and suggested changes.

The committee reviewed previously drafted recommendations in the IoL guideline and discussed edits.
