1. Welcome and objectives for the meeting

4. Morning presentations

The Chair introduced Eva Gonzalez, Senior Systematic Reviewer, who presented the re-run results for evidence review loLQ2: What are the benefits and harms associated with pharmacological and mechanical methods of inducing labour in women who request labour induction?

The Chair introduced Paul Jacklin, Senior Health Economist, who presented the updated

network meta-analysis (NMA) results, pairwise analysis and health economics for evidence review IoLQ2: What are the benefits and harms associated with pharmacological and mechanical methods of inducing labour in women who request labour induction?

5. Afternoon presentations

The Chair introduced Hilary Eadon, Guideline Lead, who presented the misoprostol warnings for induction of labour.

Hilary Eadon led the committee through a review of recommendations for the Inducing labour guideline.

The Chair introduced James Gilbert, Senior Systematic Reviewer, who presented the research recommendations for evidence review IoLQ3: At what gestational age should induction of labour be offered if spontaneous labour does not ensue?

The committee discussed the updated NMA results presented for IoLQ2 and revised the IoL recommendations.
