## Safe Prescribing Guideline: Full list of Clinical Questions

- 1. What are the risk factors (both patient and prescribing factors) for dependence on prescribed opioids, benzodiazepines, Z-drugs or gabapentinoids, or withdrawal symptoms associated with antidepressants?
- 2. What are the optimum prescribing strategies or interventions delivered alongside prescribing, to limit the risk of dependence or withdrawal symptoms?
- 3. What should be included in a review of prescribed medicines associated with dependence or withdrawal symptoms?
- 4. What is the optimal frequency of review of prescribed medicines associated with dependence or withdrawal symptoms?
- 5. What are the withdrawal symptoms associated with prescribed medicines?
- 6. What are the most clinically and cost effective pharmacological and non-pharmacological strategies, for example tapered withdrawal or education and support, for the safe withdrawal of prescribed medicines associated with dependence or withdrawal symptoms (opioids, benzodiazepines, z-drugs, gabapentinoids and anti-depressants)?
- 7. What information and support is needed by people who may develop dependence, or who have developed dependence or withdrawal symptoms and their families and carers
