1. Welcome, apologies, introductions and objectives

4. Evidence review presentation for RQ3.1 What partner notification strategies for STIs are effective and cost-effective?

Robby Richey, Technical Adviser presented 7 RCTs for inclusion in the evidence for differing partner notification methods.

Joshua Pink, Technical Adviser (Health Economics) presented the single study included for the cost-effectiveness evidence.

The Committee had the opportunity to ask questions.

5. Committee discussion

The Committee discussed the evidence presented to them and considered whether this impacts the findings of the review.

6. Evidence review presentation for RQ3.2 What is the acceptability to of partner notification strategies for STIs?

Hannah Stockton, Technical Adviser presented 10 qualitative studies included for the evidence on the acceptability of partner notification.

The Committee had the opportunity to ask questions.

7. Committee discussion and recommendation drafting

The Committee discussed the findings of the partner notification review and input their own expertise to begin drafting appropriate recommendations.

Hamish Mohammed was excluded from participating in recommendation drafting as he has authored papers included in the evidence base.

1. Welcome, apologies, introductions and objectives

6. Protocols for RQ2.1-RQ 2.3 testing – committee discussion

Committee preference was discussed, and the parameters agreed for the testing evidence reviews.

7. Potential areas for expert testimony

Hannah Stockton, Technical Analyst and Robby Richey, Technical Adviser asked the committee to consider potential areas or gaps in the evidence which might be suitable for expert testimony.

Committee offered their suggestions along with suitable contacts and organisations.
