### 4. Update on Trailblazer project

The Chair introduced Susan Otiti, Topic Expert member of the committee, who provided an update on the national Trailblazer pilot in Haringey. The committee were then given the opportunity to ask questions.

### 5. Feedback on plans for engaging with children and young people

LE revisited with the Committee options for effective engagement with children and young people, who are not old enough to sit on a committee and fed back from a meeting held by a sub-group of the committee formed to discuss this. The Committee discussed the issues presented to them and LE and HM agreed to relay the committee's preferences for further internal discussion at NICE.

#### 6. Editorial presentation

The Chair introduced Annette Meade, Senior Editor at NICE who discussed the role of the Editor in developing the guideline and the support the Editor provides the committee and to the NICE team.

7. Review Question 5.1a What is the effectiveness and cost-effectiveness of targeted mental health support interventions for children in primary education?

Review Question 5.1b What is the effectiveness and cost-effectiveness of targeted mental health support interventions for children and young people in secondary and further education?

SB presented the qualitative evidence identified for targeted mental health support interventions for the Committee's consideration. The Committee discussed the evidence and drafted three recommendations.

#### 8. Next steps

HM discussed and agreed with the committee a proposal from the NICE team to split the review question on universal interventions into 4 subtopics based on what the interventions aim to do, being: promote good social and emotional wellbeing, prevent poor social and emotional wellbeing, promote good mental health & prevent poor mental health.
