1. Welcome and objectives for the meeting

Morning presentations

The Chair introduced Mia Schmidt-Hansen, NGA Senior Systematic Reviewer and Rachel Connolly, NGA Systematic Reviewer who led a Review protocol discussions on review questions 5.1 How should people who have self-harmed first be contacted following assessment? And 3.1 How should assessment for people who have self-harmed be undertaken in non-specialist settings, such as: primary care, social care, community pharmacy, ambulances, emergency departments, schools, colleges and

universities, the criminal justice system and immigration removal centres, acute general hospitals?

Mia Schmidt-Hansen and Rachel Connolly took questions from the group. The Chair thanked Mia and Rachel for their presentations.

Afternoon presentations

Mia Schmidt-Hansen, NGA Senior Systematic Reviewer and Rachel Connolly, NGA Systematic Reviewer led Review protocol discussions on review questions 3.2 How should assessment for people who have self-harmed be undertaken in specialist settings, such as: community mental health services, inpatient mental health services? And 4.1 What are the benefits and harms of a risk assessment and formulation including those models or tools that combine elements of machine learning and artificial intelligence for people who have self harmed?

Mia Schmidt-Hansen and Rachel Connolly took questions from the group.

Furthermore, Katherine Andrea led the Lay member concerns agenda item, where Lay members can express overall concerns or raise any concerns about the discussions during each committee meeting.
