1. Welcome and objectives for the meeting

The Chair welcomed the Committee members and attendees to day 1 of the 9th guideline committee meeting on Self Harm: assessment, management and preventing recurrence.

The Chair informed the Committee of the apologies received, which are noted above.

The Chair reminded all present that the Committee is independent and advisory, that its decisions and recommendations to NICE do not represent final NICE guidance, and that they may be changed as a result of public consultation.

The Chair outlined the objectives of the meeting and discussed the meeting etiquette for the virtual meeting.

2. Confirmation of matter under discussion, and declarations of interest

GC members were asked to submit any new declarations to the Project Manager after the meeting.

3. Minutes of the last meeting

The minutes from the last meeting were approved and accurate, no amendments were made.

4. Presentations

Morning presentations

The Chair welcome two external attendees David McDaid, an Associate Professorial Research Fellow in Health Policy and Health Economics, London School of Economics and Political Science and Keith Hawton, Director of the Centre for Suicide Research and Professor of Psychiatry University Department of Psychiatry Warneford Hospital, who gave a presentation to the committee on the Health Economic data from Multicentre Study of psychosocial assessment following hospital presenting self-harm. The Chair thanked David McDaid and Katrina for their presentation.

The Committee, led by Katherine Andrea, Guideline Lead reviewed the edited recommendations for 3.2.

Afternoon presentations

The Chair introduced Katherine Andrea, NGA Guideline Lead who presented the Committee with the Assessment recs for 3.1, How should assessment for people who have self-harmed be undertaken in non-specialist settings such as primary care, social care, community pharmacy, ambulances, emergency departments (by non-specialist staff), schools, colleges and universities, the criminal justice system and immigration removal centres, acute general hospitals?

The Chair introduced Rachel Connolly, NGA Systematic Reviewer who gave a presentation on Review question 5.1 What are the components of effective follow-up for people who have self-harmed? Rachel Connolly took questions from the group. The Chair thanked Rachel for her presentation.

5. Questions and discussion

The Chair Jeremy Isaacs led the Lay member concerns agenda item, there were no concerns raised at the meeting by the Lay members.

The Committee discussed each presentation in relation to this guideline and were given the opportunity to ask questions.
