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In people aged 16 years or over with suspected acute respiratory infection (ARI):

- RQ 1.1 What are the signs, symptoms and early warning scores (EWS) that have been evaluated?
- RQ 1.2 What are the strategies for the triage of patients (for example, applying clinical prediction rules using signs, symptoms, EWS thresholds) to avoid serious illness?
- RQ 1.3 What is the clinical effectiveness and cost-effectiveness of different near-patient, rapid microbiological or biomarker tests alone or in combination to guide initial assessment and management in people aged 16 and over with suspected ARI?
- RQ 1.4 In people aged over 16, what is the diagnostic accuracy of near-patient, rapid tests to distinguish between bacterial and viral infection in suspected acute respiratory infection?
