1. Welcome and objectives for the meeting

6. RQ 3.3 (a, b, c) PICOs

RQ 3.3a - What antibiotic treatment regimens (including choice of antimicrobial agent, dosage, route and duration of administration) are effective in the treatment of suspected bacterial meningitis prior in younger infants (excluding neonates) before or in the absence of identifying the causative infecting organism?

RQ 3.3b - What antibiotic treatment regimens (including choice of antimicrobial agent, dosage, route and duration of administration) are effective in treating suspected bacterial meningitis in older infants and children before or in the absence of identifying the causative infecting organism?



RQ 3.3c - What antibiotic treatment regimens (including choice of antimicrobial agent, dosage, route and duration of administration) are effective in treating suspected bacterial meningitis in adults before or in the absence of identifying the causative infecting organism?
