1. Welcome, housekeeping, aims of the day and apologies

The Chair welcomed the committee members and attendees to the 10th meeting on Ovarian Cancer: Identifying and Managing Familial and Genetic Risk.

4. Morning presentations

The Chair introduced Laura Berg, Systematic Reviewer, Eric Slade, Senior Health Economist and Adam Rosenthal, 8.1 Topic Group Lead who presented on evidence review 8.1: 'How effective is risk-reducing surgery for women at increased risk of familial ovarian cancer (also considering risk threshold, age and extent and types of

surgery)?

Eric Slade, Senior Health Economist, gave an update on the economics work for Topic 4 including model assumptions and parameter inputs.

Katharina Dworzynski, Guideline Lead, gave a presentation on algorithm preference sensitive decision points, which included examples from other guidelines.

5. Lay member forum

Lay members were given the opportunity to reflect and make any suggestions or comments to the other committee members.

6. Afternoon presentations

The Chair introduced Suhayl Kassam, Systematic reviewer, and Britta Stordal, 5.1 Topic Group Lead, who presented evidence review question 5.1: 'Which genes should be included in a gene panel when testing for pathogenic variants that increase the risk of familial ovarian cancer?'

7. Questions and discussion

The committee discussed:

- Clinical evidence and economic evidence for 8.1. They drafted recommendations using topic group suggestions as a starting point and took into account equality considerations.
- Economic update for Topic 4
- Algorithm/ preference sensitive decision points.
- Clinical evidence for review question 5.1 They drafted recommendations using topic group suggestions as a starting point and took into account equality considerations.

8. Any other business and summary of actions

Katharina Dworzynski summarised the actions and confirmed the topics for the next meeting.
