1. Welcome and objectives for the meeting

The Chair welcomed the committee members and attendees to the 6th meeting on multiple obstetric guidelines update. The committee members and attendees introduced themselves.

The Chair outlined the objectives of the meeting, which included: developing protocols, reviewing evidence and making/revising recommendations.

2. Confirmation of matter under discussion, and declarations of interest

The Chair confirmed that, for the purpose of managing conflicts of interest, the matters under discussion were multiple obstetric topics on hypertension in pregnancy (HiP), ectopic pregnancy (EP), caesarean section (CS), induction of labour (IoL) and preterm labour and birth (PTLB).

Evidence review of question HiP7:

Louise Geneen presented the evidence review for question HiP7: How effective are spot protein/creatinine ratio or albumin/creatinine ratio measurements as compared with a 24-hour urine collection for the identification of proteinuria in women with hypertensive disorders of pregnancy?

5. Afternoon presentations

Discussion of protocol CS1:

Katie Webster presented the protocol for review question:

CS1: What are the risks and benefits (short and long term) of planned caesarean section compared with planned vaginal birth at term for women and neonates/infants/children?

Evidence review of question CS2:

Eva Gonzalez presented the evidence review for question CS2: What methods, apart from prophylactic antibiotics, should be used to reduce infectious morbidity in women undergoing CS?

6. Questions and discussions

The committee discussed the evidence presented for HiP7 and CS2 and made recommendations.

The committee discussed the protocol for CS1 and agreed for it to be brought back to the next meeting for further discussion and sign-off.

The committee made some revisions to the recommendations for the HiP guideline. The committee also commented on the draft algorithm and agreed to the addition of a further research recommendation.
