- 1. Apologies were received from Tony Clifford, Judith James, Aine Rose Kelly, Clifford Middleton, Clare Morgan. Kenny Ross and Miriam Silver
- 2. No new interests were declared.
- 3. The minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed for accuracy and confirmed.
- 4. Care leavers and carer representatives were asked to express any concerns.
- 5. The environmental risk factors review from the last meeting was revisited. Outcomes looked at were security, insecurity and disorganisation. The setting included children in the home living with their biological parents.
- 6. The process and arrangement risk factors review was presented and revisited (40 papers from 4000 abstracts). Studies were looking at the movement of the children within the system to ascertain whether there was a higher likelihood of children entering into adoption or being reunited with their parents.
- 7. The maltreatment review was presented. It looked at which interventions are effective for promoting secure attachment and related outcomes in children and young people on the edge of care, who have been or are at risk of being maltreated.
- 8. The health economist provided an update on what had been presented at the last meeting. A summary of model inputs was looked at. Conviction rates and number of convictions were updated using data reported in Eckenrode et al 2010.
- 9. Recommendations drafted for children on the edge of care were reviewed by the GDG.
- 10. The GDG reviewed the writing plan. Gaps were identified and the GDG agreed to submit any missing draft sections by the first week of January.
