One stakeholder has commented that there is a small amount of evidence that people from the black and minority ethnic community have different support and information needs and a varying experience in access to information and clinical trials. No reference was provided for this evidence.

The Committee have reviewed the evidence identified and appraised on the information and support needs for people with myeloma and could not find anything within this evidence to support that the information and support needs of the BME community are different to those of any other people with myeloma. Therefore no specific recommendations have been made for this group of people.
