1. Welcome, apologies and GDG3 minutes

IS welcomed the group to the fourth meeting of this guideline development group.

The minutes and notes of GDG3 were agreed as a true and accurate record of the meeting.

2. **Declarations of interest**

The following declaration of interest was provided by AA-M under the category of nonpersonal pecuniary interest: AAM is the principal investigator for three trials; LIVE:LIFE, PARAGON and Serelaxin in Acute Heart Failure, which all focus on heart failure. The LIVE:LIFE trial, sponsored by Servier Laboratories, is focused on a group of people in the UK over 70 years of age who have recently been started on a treatment with a drug called ivabradine for heart failure. The PARAGON trial, funded by Novartis, will test the LCZ696 drug in patients with heart failure with preserved ejection fraction (HF-PEF). The Serelaxin trial, sponsored by Novartis, is a study to confirm and expand the efficacy, safety and tolerability evidence of 48 hours intravenous infusion of serelaxin in patients admitted to hospital for Acute Heart Failure. None of these trials relate to preoperative testing, and are not directly relevant to the guideline. Therefore no action was taken.

The remaining GDG members all declared that they knew of no personal specific, personal non-specific, non-personal specific or non-personal non-specific interest in the development of this guideline.

The GDG reviewed and refined the LETR table for the CPET review.

4. HbA1c (in people with undiagnosed diabetes) LETR
