1. Welcome and objectives for the meeting

The Chair welcomed the Committee members and attendees to the third meeting on Oral health for adults in care homes. The Chair gave special welcome to Ann Williams as a new core member and Victoria Elliot as a coopted topic member. The Committee members and attendees introduced themselves. The Chair noted that the Centre for Public Health and Social Care at NICE is currently recruiting for core PHAC members.

The Chair welcomed the members of the public to the meeting. The members of the public had been briefed already, both verbally and in writing by the NICE team, and the Chair reminded them of the protocol for members of the public, whose role is to observe (they should not speak or ask questions). No filming or recording of the meeting is permitted. The Chair reminded all present that the Committee is independent and advisory, that its decisions and recommendations to NICE do not represent final NICE guidance, and that they may be changed as a result of public consultation.

The Chair informed the Committee that apologies had been received. These are noted above.

The Chair outlined the objectives of the meeting, which included:

receiving an update on the progress with the economic analyses

- discussing the findings of the evidence review 3 (barriers and facilitators)
- developing draft recommendations, considerations and research recommendations

The Committee discussed the issues and the Chair thanked CEDAR for their presentation.

The Chair introduced Ilona Jonson from SURE, who gave a presentation on the draft review relating to barriers and facilitators to approaches for adult nursing and residential care homes on promoting oral health, preventing dental health problems and ensuring access to dental treatment.

The Committee discussed the issues and the Chair thanked SURE for their presentation.

The Committee thanked Andrew and Ilona for their presentations and contribution to the development of the guideline.

5. Questions and discussion

The Committee discussed the evidence reviews that had been presented and were given the opportunity to ask questions.

The Committee were informed that there is still time to hear expert testimony which

will help to fill any gaps there may be in the evidence.

6. Drafting recommendations and considerations

The Committee drafted recommendations and considerations based on the evidence presented.

Action: The NICE team will circulate a version of the oral health care assessment tool once copyright issues have been determined.

7. Drafting research recommendations

The committee gave some thought to drafting research recommendations.

8. Summary of the day and next steps

Linda Sheppard (LS) summarised the discussions from the day and reported on action points from the last meeting.

LS updated the committee on expert testimony to bridge gaps in the evidence for oral health in care homes. LS confirmed there will be a presentation to the PHAC about NHS Commissioning on 24th June.

It was noted that no response has been received from approaches made to organisations to bridge the evidence gap about oral health and disability.

Action: Prompted by the NICE team, committee members will send suggestions to the NICE team before meeting on 24th June.

The next meeting will take place on 24th June followed by a two day meeting in September. It was noted that all of the reviews discussed today will be placed on the NICE website during the consultation for the draft guideline from 10th November until 22nd December 2015.

The Chair thanked the committee for their contribution to draft recommendations and thanked the review teams for their hard work.
