1. Introduction, apologies and minutes

SW welcomed the group to the eleventh meeting of this GDG. Apologies were received from WM. PS and CW.

2. Declaration of interests

3. Evidence review: MBR

ROM presented the clinical evidence review for multidisciplinary biopsychosocial rehabilitation. KL presented the health economic evidence. The GDG discussed the evidence and drafted recommendations.

4. Summary of the reviews

ROM and the GDG reviewed summaries of the evidence for acupuncture, electrotherapy, exercise and manual therapy, and reviewed the provisionally drafted recommendations.

5. Network meta-analysis (NMA) presentation/health economic modelling and discussion

SC gave a presentation about the pros and cons of a NMA and why they are performed. KL presented the considerations from a health economics perspective and relevance to the economic modelling. The GDG discussed the non-invasive evidence. The GDG discussed the key points presented.

SC noted that the items on the agenda, summaries of the evidence for orthotics, pharmacology, postural, psychological and self-management, and chapter introductions, which had not been discussed, would be circulated to the GDG members after the GDG, and that the remaining summary reviews would be looked at in GDG12.
