

# Economic plan

## 1 Guideline

HIV testing: encouraging uptake among at risk groups

List of modelling questions

<b>Review questions by scope area</b>	What are the most effective and cost-effective ways to increase the uptake of HIV testing to reduce undiagnosed HIV among people who may have been exposed to it?
Population	People who may have undiagnosed HIV infection.
Interventions and comparators considered for inclusion	Interventions aimed at testing to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Increasing awareness of HIV testing services</li> <li>• Increasing awareness of the benefits of HIV testing</li> <li>• Increasing the uptake of a HIV test and/or increasing the offer of a HIV test</li> </ul> <p>Comparator: other intervention, usual care.</p>
Perspective	Public sector – service level
Outcomes	Outcomes of the analysis will seek to assess costs and resource impact of the tests in relation to standard care and where possible the lifetime cost of treatment.
Type of analysis	A cost assessment around resource impact
