4. Steve Pilling highlighted the aims for the 2 day GC meeting.
5. Eric Slade, the Health Economist gave a presentation on the Therapeutic Communities health economic model
6. SP gave an update on the Physical Health in Prisons guideline and how our recommendations fit into it.
7. The GC went through the draft recommendations, which is going out for consultation. SP noted that the GC can give feedback on the other guideline during the consultation period.
