Specific consideration will be given to the needs of children and pregnant women.

Differing outcomes associated with different ethnic groups (e.g. South Asian family origin) and people with learning disabilities will be considered.

Consideration will be given with regards to self-management plans and patient information for those people who have sight, reading or language barriers.

1.2 What is the preliminary view on the extent to which these potential equality issues need addressing by the Committee? None of the 8 protected groupings is excluded.

Optimal management of children is likely to differ from that of adults. The range of licensed medications differs slightly, and the best management options at any stage of severity may not be the same. Recommendations for children are therefore likely to be different than those for adults.

Optimal management of asthma in pregnancy may differ from that of non-pregnant people with asthma. There is evidence of worse outcomes of asthma during pregnancy, although this is probably because women sometimes stop taking medication when pregnant rather than because of any intrinsic change in the asthma. The GDG will consider this when appraising evidence.

There is some evidence that outcomes from asthma are worse in those of South Asian ethnic origin, and the developers will consider whether this merits any management recommendations specific to this group.

One stakeholder commented that consideration should be made with regards to written asthma action plans and patient information for those people who have sight, reading or language barriers.
