Advice

NICE is unable to make a recommendation about the use in the NHS of niraparib with abiraterone acetate and prednisone for untreated hormone-relapsed metastatic prostate cancer in adults. This is because Johnson & Johnson Innovative Medicine has confirmed that it does not intend to make an evidence submission for the appraisal. Johnson & Johnson Innovative Medicine considers that the technology is unlikely to be used at this point in the treatment pathway.

Information
