One stakeholder noted that Black, Asian and minority ethnic people with cystic fibrosis are less likely to be eligible for current CFTR modulators as they are more likely to have rare mutations.

The committee will consider whether its recommendations could have a different impact on people protected by the equality legislation. The committee can only consider treatments within their marketing authorisation.
