

Obinutuzumab with mycophenolate mofetil for treating lupus nephritis

Information for the public

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Obinutuzumab (Gazyvaro) plus mycophenolate mofetil is available on the NHS. It is a possible treatment for active class 3 or 4 (with or without class 5) lupus nephritis in adults.

Is this treatment right for me?
