NICE is unable to make a recommendation about the use in the NHS of canagliflozin for treating type 2 diabetes in people 10 to 17 years. This is because Menarini has confirmed that it does not intend to make an evidence submission for the appraisal. Menarini considers that there is not enough evidence to provide an evidence submission for this appraisal.
