

# Amivantamab with carboplatin and pemetrexed for untreated EGFR exon 20 insertion mutation-positive advanced non-small-cell lung cancer

Amivantamab (Rybrevant) with carboplatin and pemetrexed is available during the [managed access](#) period. It is a possible treatment for untreated advanced non-small-cell lung cancer with activating EGFR exon 20 insertion mutations in adults.

More evidence on amivantamab with carboplatin and pemetrexed is being collected. After this, NICE will decide whether to recommend it for use on the NHS and update the guidance. It will be available during the managed access period until then.

If you are not eligible for amivantamab with carboplatin and pemetrexed but are already having it, you should be able to continue until you and your healthcare professional decide when best to stop.

## Is this treatment right for me?

Your healthcare professionals should give you clear information, talk with you about your options and listen carefully to your views and concerns. Your family can be involved too, if you wish. See [our webpage on shared decision making](#).

- How well does it work compared with other treatments?
- What are the risks or side effects? How likely are they?
- How will the treatment affect my day-to-day life?
- What happens if the treatment does not work?
