Health Technology Appraisal Coronary artery stents for the prevention of ischaemic heart disease (review of guidance no. 71)

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the assessment report on the use of coronary artery stents for the prevention of ischaemic heart disease.

Colleagues here who commented on the report expressed concern that the overall impression is that much of the trial evidence is not comparable or insufficiently long term, resulting in difficulties in drawing firm conclusions. They were also concerned that the cost effectiveness data within the report shows huge variation. Colleagues understanding of the international experience would appear to conflict with the report's conclusion.
