#### Consideration of consultation responses on review proposal

#### Review of TA235; Mifamurtide for the treatment of osteosarcoma

This guidance was issued October 2011 with a review date of November 2013.

#### Background

At the GE meeting of 22 October 2013 it was agreed we would consult on the review plans for this guidance. A four week consultation has been conducted with consultees and commentators and the responses are presented below.

Proposal put to consultees:	TA235 should be transferred to the 'static guidance list.	
Rationale for selecting this proposal	No evidence has been identified that would lead to a change in the recommendations of the original guidance. No relevant ongoing studies have been identified.	

GE is asked to consider the original proposal in the light of the comments received from consultees and commentators, together with any responses from the appraisal team. It is asked to agree on the final course of action for the review.
