Available data in current practice shows variation in treatment by gender and ethnicity.

People with chronic kidney disease are excluded as they are the focus of a separate indicator (see NM213). People with a history of haemorrhagic stroke are excluded as the risk of further haemorrhage may outweigh the risk of a vascular event.
