This indicator establishes a register of people with coronary heart disease with the aim of

facilitating subsequent intervention and support. It should include all those with a history of angina, coronary artery revascularisation or myocardial infarction.

A register of people with coronary heart disease.

Exclusions: People with cardiac X syndrome.

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
