2. There were no interests to be declared.

4. The GDG discussed the option of hosting a focus group for service users
5. There were no social care concerns discussed.
6. RN presented to the group on the review protocol, methods of evaluating tools, results on the literature search and sift, included and excluded studies, and sensitivity and specificity data for the included case identification tools.
7. FK presented the results of the evidence search for pharmacological interventions, particularly antipsychotics, which constituted the largest group of RCTs.
8. BA presented to the GDG on HE guidelines methodology, the inclusion and exclusion criteria for studies, applicability criteria, quality criteria, and the specific studies that have been included and assessed.
9. CW explained to the GDG that the full guideline methods chapter will be updated during development.
10. CW presented to the group on the conduct disorders guideline systematic review protocol, and on existing reviews relevant to the guideline review questions.
