## **Notes**

- 1. PB welcomed the group, introduced himself and briefly outlined the development process of a short guideline. Apologies were received from CC and KPF. The GDG was asked to read and adhere to the NICE policy for declaring and dealing with conflicts of interest. The chair reviewed and requested updates to the declarations of interest register. The GDG member verbally declared their DOIs (as per DOI register). The following DOIs were submitted:
  - KC declared he was a member of the Joined up Clinical Pathways for obesity, CRG for severe and complex obesity, and member of the advisory group group on review of Bariatric Surgery 2009 and 2013 (not yet published). KC is also joint successful applicant with Plymouth University and Diabetes UK for the Patent Office 2014 fast forward awards to develop health apps - awarded 75K
  - o MoK and RW are also members of the CRG for severe and complex obesity.
  - JW is attending the American Diabetes Association meeting in June, and being supported by Boehringer-Ingleheim (economy travel + accommodation and conference registration).

The chair agreed there were no conflicts of interest for which any action was required.

- 3. **People with learning disabilities who are obese or overweight:** CM gave a presentation introducing this subject to the GDG.
- 4. Role of the NICE editor:

This definition has been agreed with NICE and the GDG.
